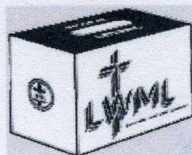

Beautiful Feet! Beautiful Mission!

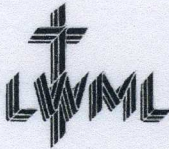

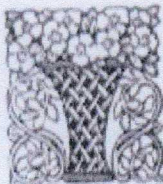
